To be considered for federal financial aid, the first step is to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Although you must be accepted for enrollment at UF before you are considered for financial aid, you should apply for aid before being admitted.

Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.gov. The FAFSA opens on October 1st of every year.

- Visit <u>studentaid.gov</u> to submit your FAFSA application.
- Ensure that you use UF's Federal School Code (001535) on your FAFSA application.
- Review your Student Aid Report (SAR), verify that all your information is correct, and address any errors or issues that you find.
- After completing your FAFSA, please send an email to <u>sfa-help@mail.ufl.edu</u> to request your financial aid award package.
